MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING CYPRESS SPRINGS OWNERS ASSOCIATION. March 14, 2016

MINUTES APPROVAL

ADMINISTRATIVE MOTIONS AND EPM ACTION ITEMS

- Management to contact CDA to discuss and negotiate amount owed to them
 by the association. The Board is asking for a \$425 reduction in labor cost that
 they feel is unwarranted.
- A motion was made by Cheryl and seconded by Winston to preserve the community documents. All agreed and the motion passed. Management will send the signed documents to the attorney for recording.
- The Board agreed that a letter, not a postcard, would be sent to all owners with trash can violations. The next letter for these owners will come from the attorney and their accounts will be charged for the cost of the attorney letter.

MAINTENANCE MOTIONS AND EPM ACTION ITEMS

- Management will ask Two Eggs to clean the cobwebs in the kitchen on a regular basis. There were also cobwebs in the kitchen cabinets.
- Alex stated at the meeting that irrigation would be up and running by the end of the week. Flowers (multi-color pansies preferably) will be installed as soon as he confirms the irrigation is working.
- No flowers are to be installed at Deer Lakes or Cypress Glen due to the deer who like to eat them.
- Landscape replacement around the clubhouse was approved for no more than \$2,696.50.
- Management was asked to call Smithson again to request completion of irrigation electrical work.
- John volunteered to check out the price of pool furniture at Costco. Winston ok'd the purchase of tables, chairs and chaise lounges for the pool area once prices are investigated.

The meeting adjourned at 8:40 with a motion from Winston.
